ILO MLC Maritime Labour Convention, 2006

- Guideline B3.1.11 - Recreational facilities, mail and ship visit arrangements
 - Par.4: Consideration should also be given to including the following facilities at no cost to the seafarer, where practicable:
 - (b) television viewing and the reception of radio broadcasts;
 - (c) showing of films, the stock of which should be adequate for the duration of the voyage and, where necessary, changed at reasonable intervals;**
 - (h) electronic equipment such as a radio, television, video recorders, DVD/CD player, personal computer and software and cassette recorder/player;



Minimum compliance scheme

- **TV sets installed:**
 - in common recreational facilities, and
 - in officers cabins
- **Stock of films**
 - Stored in a single electronic repository
 - Films broadcasted, on-demand, to any TV set
 - Stock changed at regular intervals



The ShipReel™ system

The system is modular, based on the below components:

- One ShipReel™ **server** (black box)
- Any number of ShipReel™ **media boxes** with **remote control**
- Ultra hi-density **DVDs** used for regular films stock replenishment

Simply put the system in use...

- System is delivered on-ship
- Server installed in bridge deck electronics room, connected with vessels LAN
- Media boxes attached on TVs and connected on the LAN
- DVD's with films stock are inserted on server DVD drive; system is automatically loaded with the new films stock
- To view a film, select the video channel on the TV, while media box is connected on the TV
- Using the remote control, select any film from the on-screen list of films in stock, and press the play button
- As soon as new films stock arrives on-ship, autoload on server
